BUG BULLET KIT

CONTENTS

- 10 Bullets/ Containing 10 bugs ea.
- 10 Time Release Cloths
- 1 4oz container of Wood Putty

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Drill a hole $\frac{1}{2}$ " in diameter and 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " deep into a 2x wood structure.
- 2. Drop bullet containing 10 confused flour beetles into the drilled hole.
- 3. Cap hole with wood putty.
- 4. Perform standard fumigation procedures.
- 5. When fumigation is complete remove bullet and check for each bullet for results.
- 6. Assay test will provide a visual of live vs. dead bugs.
- 7. Before sealing hole, insert time release cloth.
- 8. Spray fumigation chemical into the hole containing inserted cloth.
- 9. Seal hole containing sprayed cloth with wood putty.
- 10. Replace the cloth every 3-6 months until next fumigation is performed.

This advanced method will protect & help prevent a structure of drywood termite colonies if performed regularly. For best results drill holes in the way of the bore tunnels that the termite travels through and additional areas that you think will help prevent the start or possibility of infestation.
